




Glimmer Of Hope Amidst The Nationwide Pandemic

Understanding the need of the hour, Moinee Foundation launched several new initiatives in states where it is currently working on different CSR projects to:

- Bridge the gaps and prioritize digital-based education for students in government schools
- Prepare teachers to face the pandemic challenges
- Deliver learning and supporting communities belonging to urban, semi-urban, rural and deep rural areas.

The foundation made this a mission to continue the spread of education since the beginning of the pandemic and have been working on it tirelessly since then.

Understanding the scenarios, our team started engaging with the Education Department and Government Officials of various districts in March 2020. This led to the launch of several initiatives to share enriched educational content for the students of the government schools with the help of teachers and community members via WhatsApp and other social media platforms.

The Foundation continues to support government school teachers, students and their families through the following activities:

- Learn at Home Series (Remote Learning) for students
- Educational Webinars for teachers & parents
- Digital Learning & Self Assessment tools
- Training & empowering students, teachers, and families for mental wellbeing
- Supporting Communities by distributing Ration Kits
- Opening Community Learning Centres

- Providing technical assistance on oxygen production




Teacher Readiness & Capacity Building Program

As part of the program, the team members visited government school teachers to explain the process of creating videos, uploading and sharing them with the students to empower teachers and facilitate the smooth running of online education.

We used the power of WhatsApp and shared effective subject material, motivational videos and guidance videos on how to create interactive teaching sessions to be shared among the students online.


Members of the team visited school faculty and organized training sessions, seminars, and tinkering workshops. During the early months of this year, the foundation was able to support workshops on interactive teaching-learning approach, webinars on mental health, parenting theory and NISTHA modules, etc. along the lines of encouraging teachers to adopt soft skills and learning pedagogy.



Remote Learning Program

The team visited schools and community centers to interact with teachers and parents on how to infuse home-based learning. This led to the development of self-guided workbooks that served as tools for learning, reflection and practice response to the needs of children.



With the assistance of the school, physical copies of the learning material are reaching every doorstep of the students. Alongside, through WhatsApp, rich educational content which includes videos, images, quizzes, games, hands-on experiments and motivational videos etc. curated by in-house learning experts is regularly shared with the students by the facilitators and teachers.



Community Learning Centres

Under the Community Engagement Program of _VOIS & Vodafone India Foundation's flagship program e-Vidya, the foundation opened 11CLCs in Maharashtra, Karnataka & Gujarat.


The centres are well-equipped learning spaces in the immediate vicinity of government schools to provide a safe space for all community members to engage in meaningful and joyful learning experiences scaffolded by an older sibling, local youth, and a dedicated facilitator.



Shift To Online Education and Self-Assessment

QuizAcademy is a learning-oriented curiosity-driven quizzing system accessible to students to measure real-time progress, understanding of the subject and learning in a fun, interactive way through quizzes. The content can be accessed even on slow internet connectivity.

QuizAcademy is one of the core tools that we use for multilingual smart class delivery. As per the need of the hour, we enhanced it to more effectively cater to the needs of the government schools' students.



Supporting Communities

To support the community members in these turbulent times, as part of _VOIS & Vodafone India Foundation's flagship program e-Vidya, the foundation tied hands with Action Aid to provide Ration Kits to communities and ensure that education is being prioritized.



Socio-Emotional Wellbeing- Empowering Mental Health

Since the pandemic demanded students as well as teachers to stay home causing uncertainty to affect their mental health, e-Vidya which is an initiative of _VOIS and Vodafone India Foundation stepped up to promote the socio-emotional wellbeing of all.


