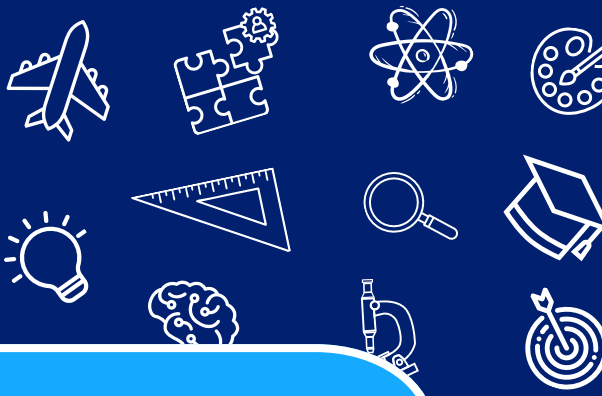

Their performances reflected not just skill, but growing confidence and creativity.



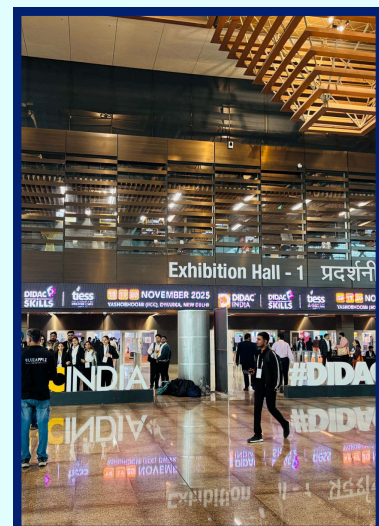
Reimagining Learning at DIDAC India 2025

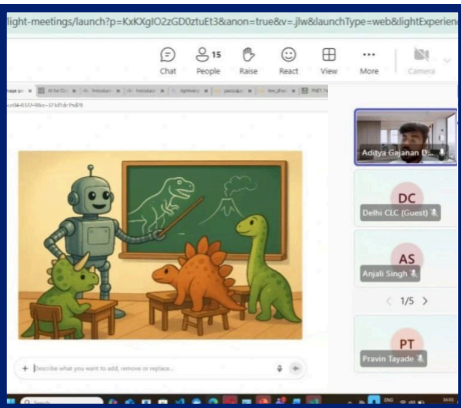
The event echoed a shared belief across the EdTech ecosystem: that scalable digital learning and community-centred interventions are not just the future — they're already transforming the last mile.

A STEP TOWARD STRONGER FINANCIAL CONFIDENCE

In Pune, all six Community Learning Centres came together on 17th November 2025 to host Financial Literacy Workshops that empowered women and young learners with practical money-management skills.

From budgeting, saving, and investing to understanding debt, insurance, and retirement planning, participants learned through engaging, easy-to-follow sessions led by Jaddu Ginni Ka trainers.

Confidence Takes Root and Courage Finds a Voice



Early November brought a different kind of learning to GMPS Kadugodi and GHPS Ramagondanahalli—one that didn't involve textbooks, screens, or scores. Instead, students stepped into conversations about feelings, fears, strength, and self-belief.



Through the MindShield Life Skills Workshop, they unpacked what it means to stay safe, aware, and emotionally grounded in a fast-changing world. And in the Warrior Mindset Workshop, they learned to recognise fear not as a barrier, but as something they can understand, navigate, and rise above.



These sessions, held under the Computer Literacy Program by WNS Cares Foundation and implemented by Moinee Foundation, became small turning points—moments where quieter voices grew steadier, hesitant ones grew braver, and young minds discovered that resilience is a skill they already carry within.



Empowering Educators in Visakhapatnam!

Teachers from nine intervention schools joined a dynamic capacity-building workshop on the Computer-Aided Learning (CAL) Program and the Happyness Literacy Program (HLP)CSR initiatives by WNS Cares Foundation, implemented by Moinee Foundation. Led by Mr. Peace Ankit, Project Manager at Moinee Foundation, the session focused on strengthening digital teaching practices and creating more joyful, engaging classrooms.



Teachers learned to use School in a Box Server and Quiz Academy platform more effectively, explored the core approach of the Happyness Literacy Program, and discussed simple ways to bring digital tools into everyday lessons. Coordinators were also trained to support schools in driving digital learning with greater confidence.

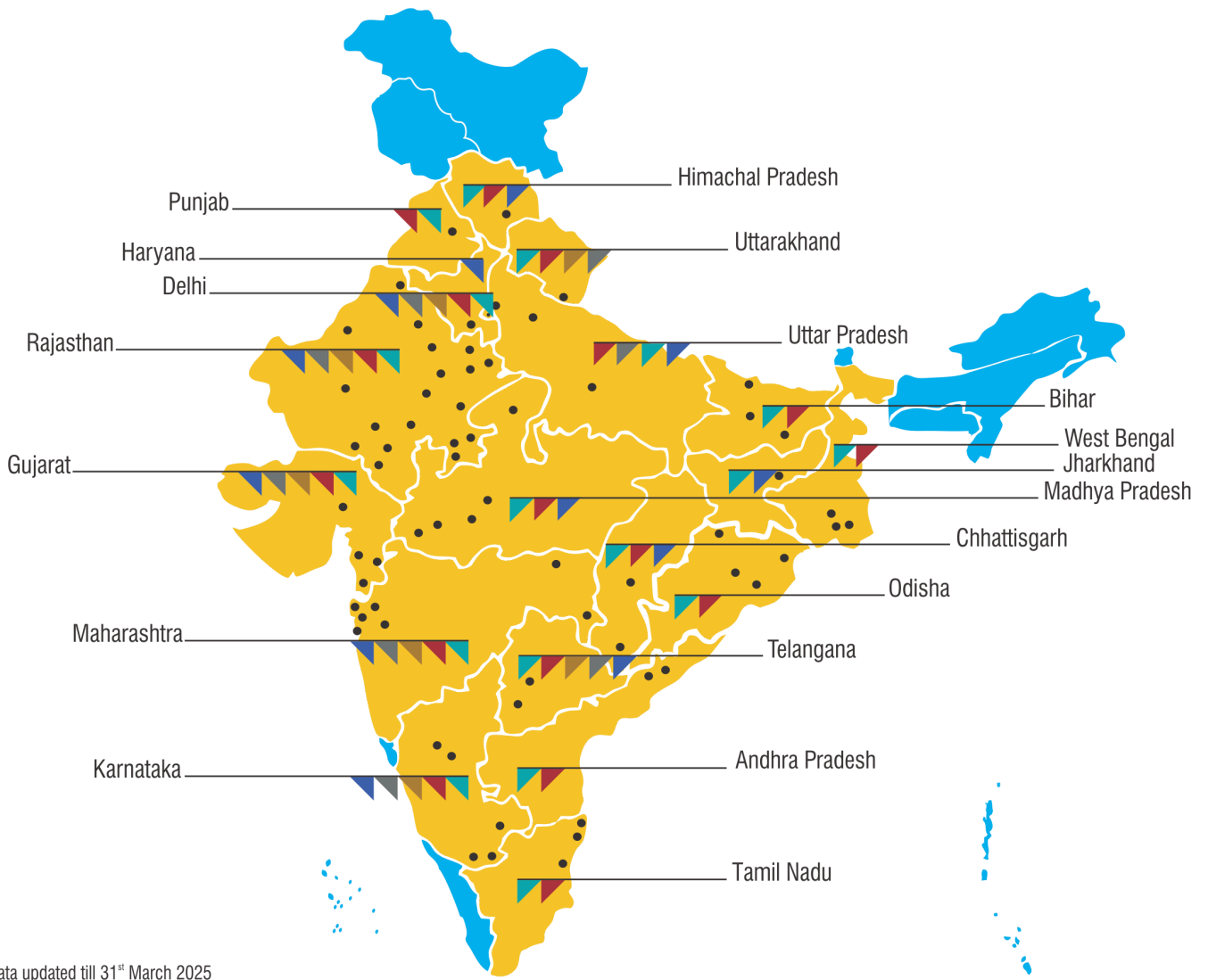
