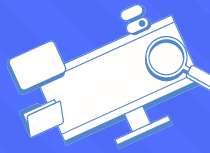

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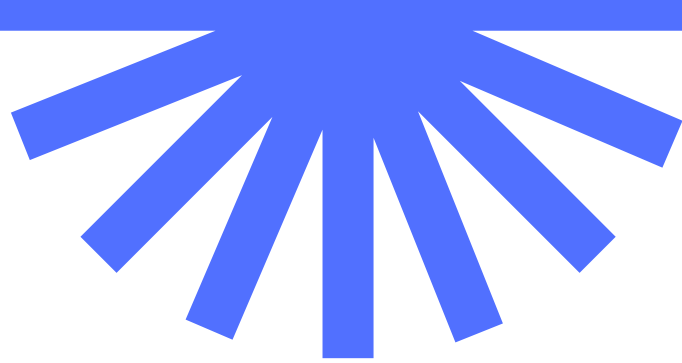

The event showcased the incredible talent within our communities, reinforcing how storytelling can inspire confidence and connection.

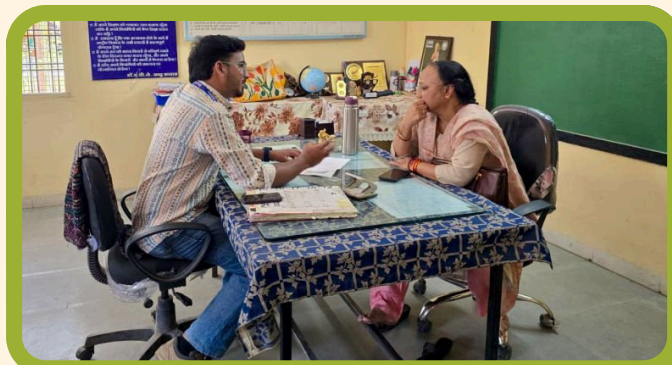

Summer Camps 2025: Where Curiosity Blossomed and Futures Took Flight

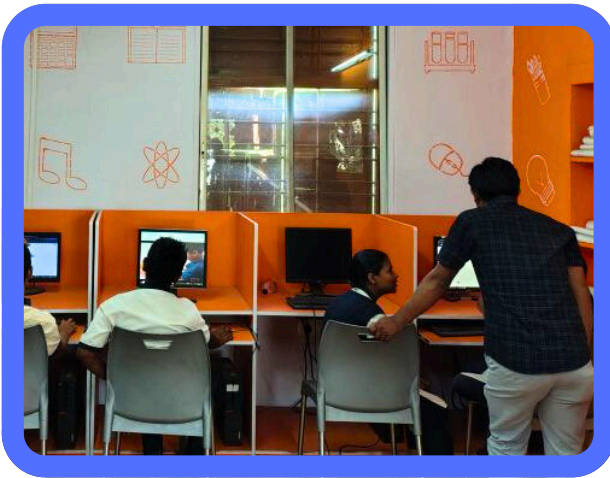

This National Technology Day, we proudly unveiled "From Crayons to Quills".

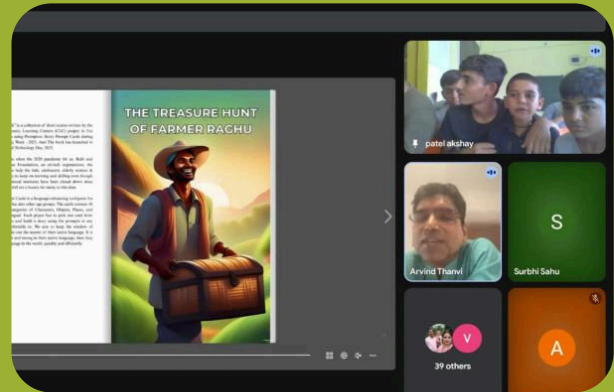

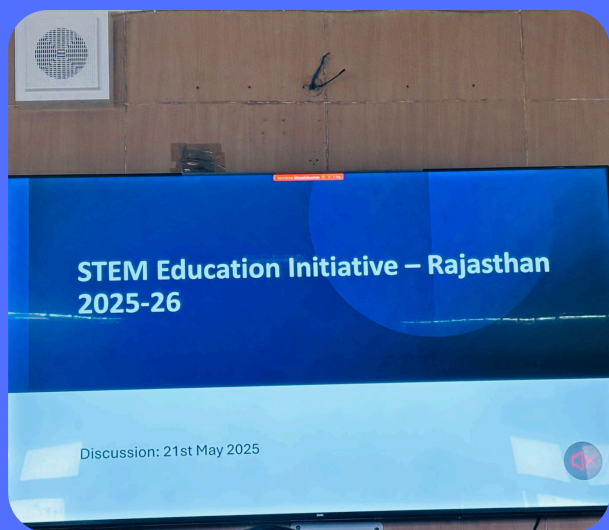
Shaping the Future of STEM Education in Rajasthan

Classrooms came alive with color, computer screens sparked curiosity, and attendance soared as learning turned into joy.

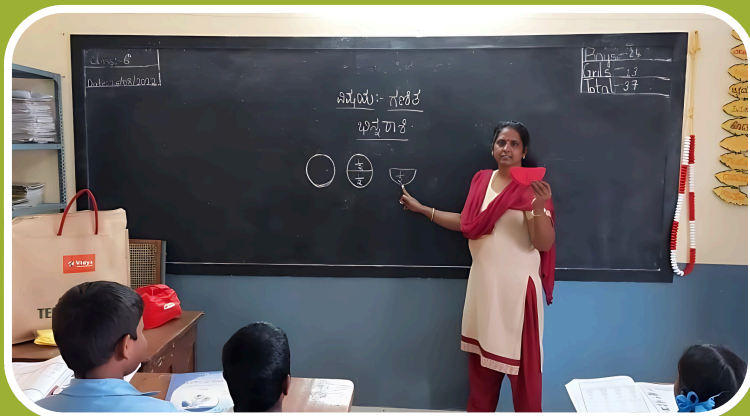
At the heart of this transformation was digital inclusion. With the introduction of computer classes, students began to see their school as a gateway to the wider world.

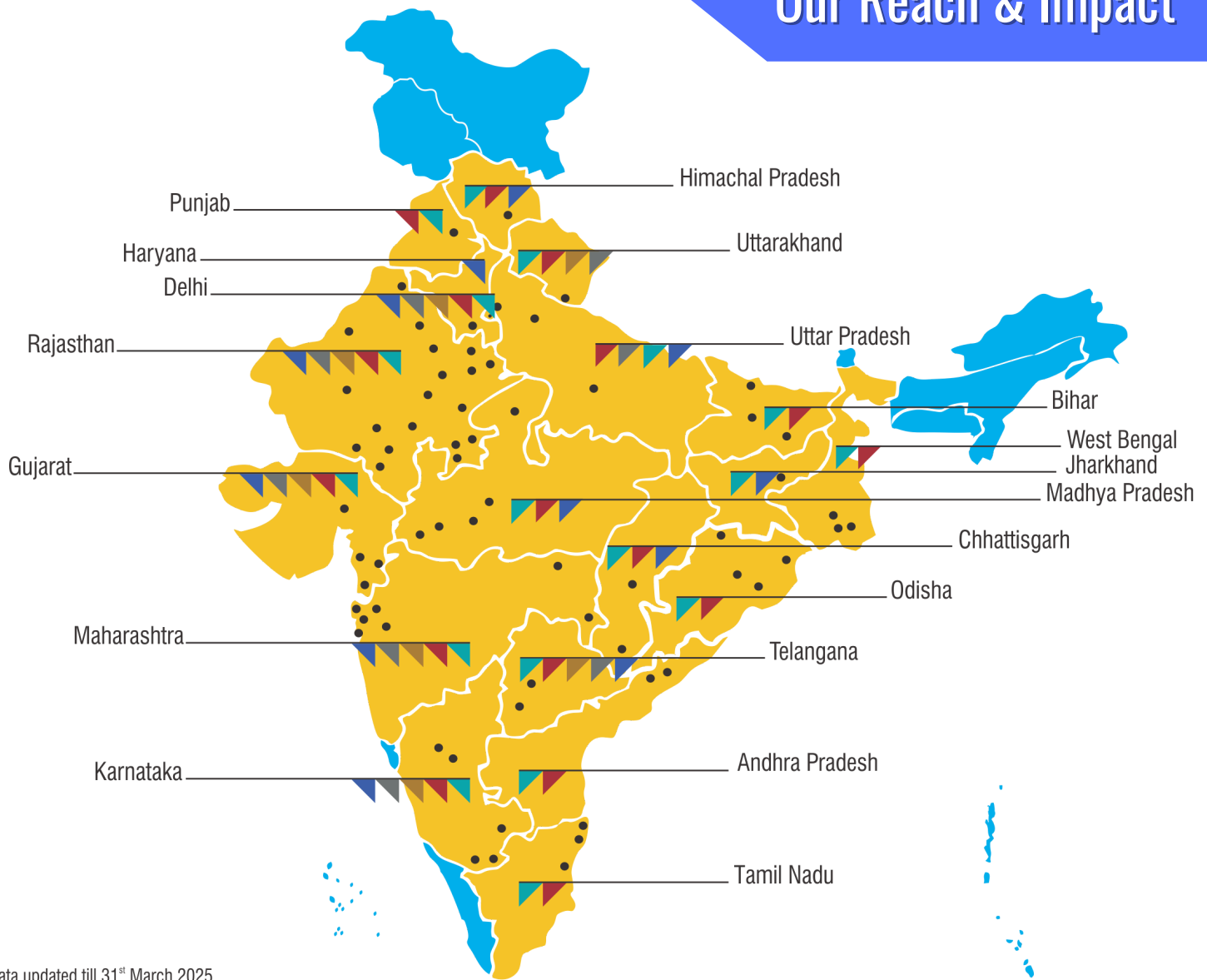
Unleashing Creativity: When Art Comes Alive
