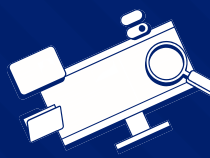

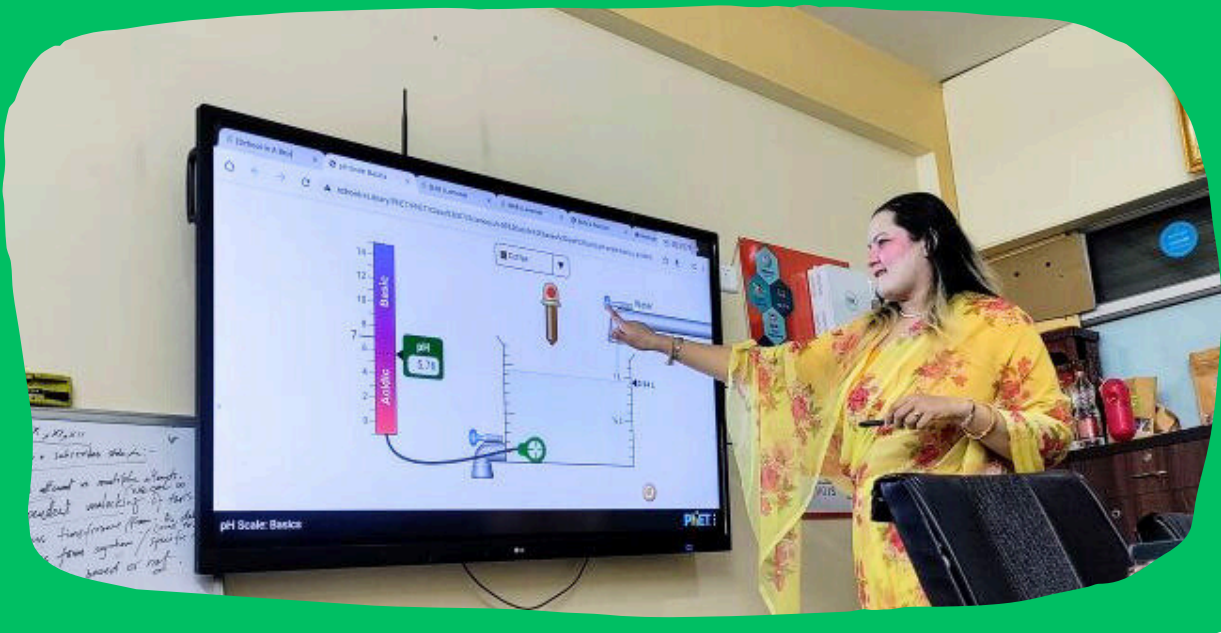

With the support of our partners, we continue to build a world where every child has the tools and opportunities to thrive.



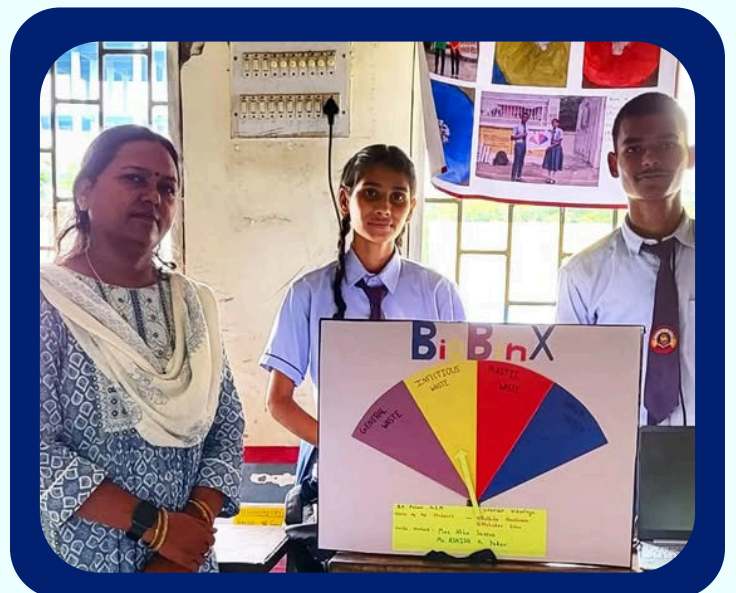
