# ECE & FLN in Action: Nurturing Young Minds at CLC's & Balwadis

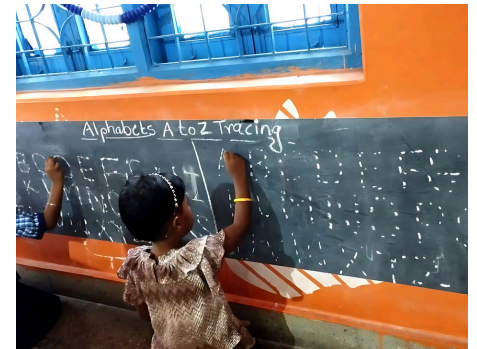

These activities are more than just play, they are carefully crafted to develop foundational literacy and numeracy skills, strengthen hand-eye coordination, and cultivate problem-solving, creativity, and curiosity.



The Math Wall, in particular, encourages children to explore numbers, patterns, and basic mathematical concepts in a fun, interactive way.



Through these structured yet enjoyable learning experiences, children gain confidence, focus, and a love for learning, laying the groundwork for future academic success and holistic development.



## **A Week of Joyful Learning and Discovery.**

In November our Community Learning Centres (CLCs) across India, came alive with textures, colours, laughter, and learning as young children engaged in thoughtfully designed sensory play and fine-motor skill activities.

These joyful moments not only supported early literacy and numeracy foundations but also nurtured confidence, creativity, and a love for learning.

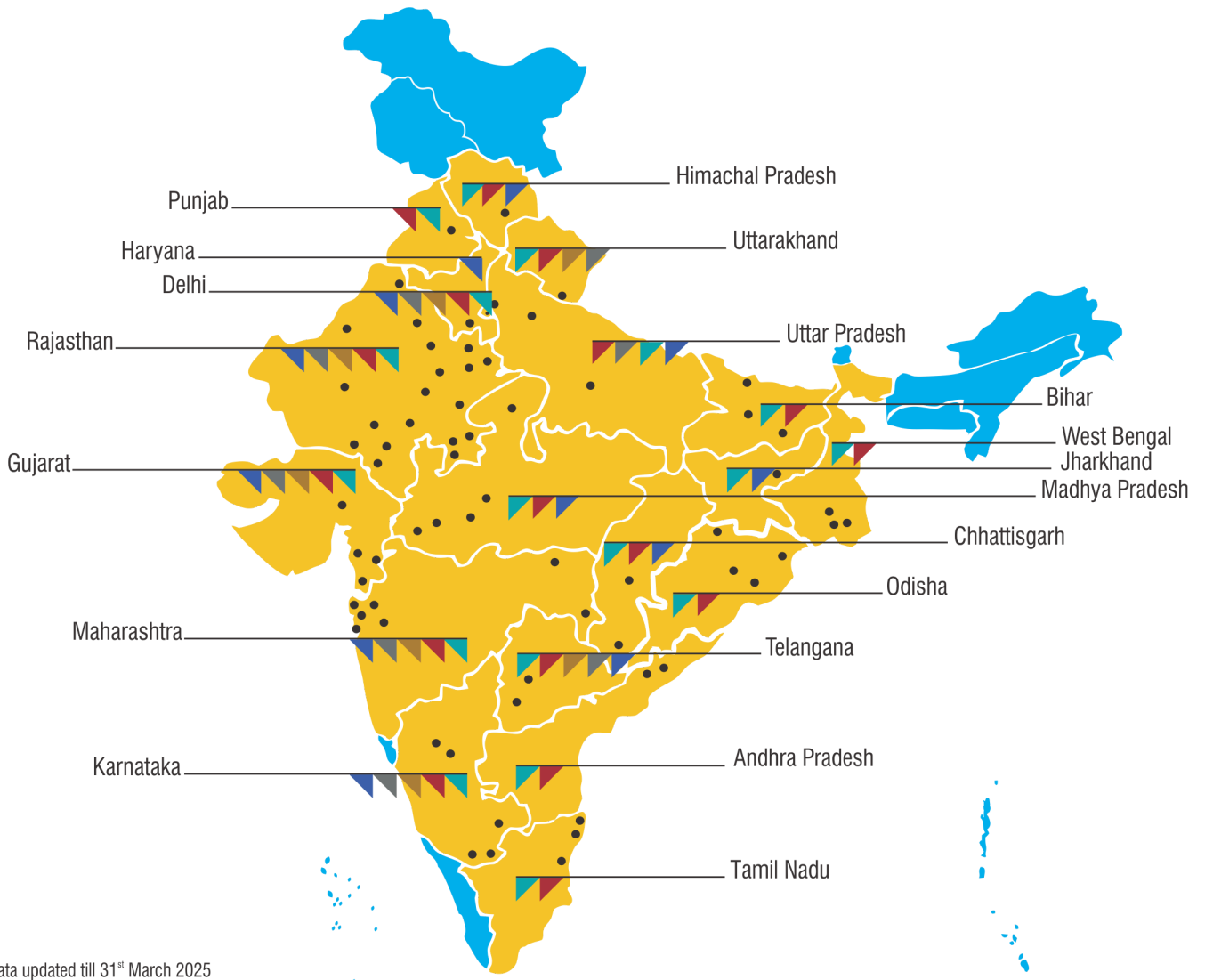
